

# SHOULD YOU BE TESTED?

**BE HONEST WITH YOURSELF.**

It only takes one time to get HIV or another STD. The simple fact is that you could be infected without even knowing it!

## **Have you ever...**

*...Shared needles with someone else?*

*...Had unprotected sex:*

*With more than one sex partner?*

*If you did, then your chances of having been with someone who had HIV or another STD go up.*

*With someone who shared needles or syringes?*

*That includes for injecting drugs, tattooing, piercing or ANY other reason. HIV and other diseases can be spread this way.*

*...Had an STD...*

*Having had an STD can make it easier to get others.*

**With many STDs, including HIV, testing is the only way to tell if you are infected.**



## ANYONE CAN BECOME INFECTED WITH HIV:

Young or old, gay or straight... it is what you do, not who you are, that puts you at risk.



**If after reviewing this brochure you feel that you could have put yourself at risk for HIV or other STDs, or you are unsure, get tested.**

Besides your primary doctor, there are other places that you can be tested. It is important that you go someplace that includes counseling before and after the test so:

- They can help you decide whether or not you need to be tested.
- They can explain how the test works and what the results mean.
- They can teach you how to protect yourself and others from HIV and other STDs.
- They can help you understand what it means if you have a positive test and what steps you should take next.
