SCPHD Offers FINAL “Head to Toe” Clinic for People with Diabetes

TWIN FALLS-The Magic Valley Diabetes Coalition is offering one last “Head to Toe” clinic for people with diabetes. Eye screenings, foot exams, blood pressure, hemoglobin A1C tests, and nutrition education will be offered free of charge to people with diabetes.

The clinic will be in Twin Falls at South Central Public Health District (located at 1020 Washington Street North) on May 15, 2013 from 9:00 a.m.to 4:00 p.m. Please call 737-5988 to schedule an appointment.

This clinic is by appointment only and open to people with diabetes that have been diagnosed by a doctor, and have never had these services or haven’t had them in a year. The public is encouraged to take advantage of these free services since this is the final “Head to Toe” clinic.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Idaho Diabetes Prevention and Control Program recommends that people with diabetes receive a dilated eye screening, a neurosensory foot examination, and a hemoglobin a1c test at least once a year.
