

Municipal sewage disposal systems requirements, as per Idaho Code 39-118; Title 50, Chapter 13:

1. Submit the completed Land Development Application (page 1)
2. Provide an engineering approval letter from DEQ if required
3. Provide a “Will Serve” letter from the municipality
 - a. This letter should specify the Parcel(s) for the project, states that the system has the willingness and capacity to serve the project, and specifies the number of lots of the proposed project.
4. Provide a Mylar plat with the appropriate Health Certificate on the face of it
5. Provide a hard copy of the plat to the HD

The Health Certificates that are to be used for subdivisions with community and municipal water and sewer systems are found in section 3.17 of the Statewide Land Development SOP Manual.
