Her efforts have been recognized for innovative public health practices at both the state and national levels. This year, SCPHD is again chosen by the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) to receive the coveted Model Practice Award for innovative practice in improving equity in community outreach.

I want to express my deep appreciation and respect for the strong leadership and support of the Board of Health. I am grateful for the opportunity to work with a team of dedicated public health professionals who serve our communities tirelessly."
