Live in Control: Free 5-Week Diabetes Self-Management Education Program Is Coming To Jerome

SOUTH CENTRAL IDAHO – South Central Public Health District (SCPHD) is excited to announce the next round of "Live in Control" diabetes self-management classes. "Live in Control" is a free 5-week program designed to educate, equip, and empower individuals with type 2 diabetes or pre-diabetes to better manage their conditions.

The program encourages participants to bring a family member or friend to attend the classes with them as a "Care Supporter." This is intended to promote a supportive environment both in class and at home. Each session is in-person and lasts two hours, with the first session being 1.5 hours to accommodate registration and A1C testing. Classes will be conducted in English by trained facilitators, with a translator available for Spanish speakers.
